Rules: This will be a Category A regatta. It will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, this Notice of Race, the Sailing instructions, and by appropriate class rules, except as any of the above are altered by the Sailing Instructions. Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration Table prior to the Skippers meeting.

Eligibility: This is an open regatta. Five or more one design or level class boats may race as a class. All others will race under the applicable handicap system, i.e., Portsmouth for boardboats, centerboarders, and multihulls, and PHRF for keelboats. PHRF numbers will be those published by the PHRF of the Alamo currently being used for racing on Canyon Lake. The PHRF list is posted on the LCYC website at www.lcyc.net. Boats not covered by this list will be assigned a

number by the Wurstfest Regatta Chairman. There will be no exceptions to the above assignment of handicaps.

Classes: Anticipated classes are Sunfish, Lasers, Optimists, Flying Scots, Portsmouth, PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-spinnaker, Cruiser, and Junior (ages 18 and under). There will be up to three Portsmouth classes for Beachcats grouped according to Portsmouth numbers.

Entry Fees:

\$35.00 for single-crewed boats

\$40.00 for multiple crew boats

A \$5.00 late fee will be charged any entry postmarked after October 28, 2006.

Scoring: The Low Point System noted in RRS Appendix A will apply. Five races are scheduled. One race completed shall constitute a regatta. RRS rule A2 is amended; no throwouts will be allowed unless more than 5 races are completed as noted in next sentence. Additional races may be run for single-crewed boats at the discretion of the race committee; if more than five races are completed, one throwout will be allowed.

Trophies: (entries/trophies) 5/1, 6-7/2, 8-10/3, 11-14/4, 15-18/5, 19-22/6, 23-26/7, 27-30/8, 31-34/9, 35-38/10, 39+/11.

Sail Numbers: Numbers must be displayed in accordance with RRS rule G1.

Directions:

From Hwy 281- go east on FM 306 for about 15 miles. Turn right on North Park Road (at blinking yellow light). Go 300 yards, turn right on Mt. Lookout Road. Go 1/4 mile; turn right into LCYC grounds.

From IH 35- go west on FM 306 for about 15 miles. Turn left on North Park Road (at blinking yellow light). Go 300 yards, turn right on Mt. Lookout Road. Go 1/4 mile; turn right into LCYC grounds.

Boat Storage: During the regatta, boats may be stored on or tied to the docks at the discretion of the Dockmaster, or in designated trailer storage areas. Those arriving early or leaving late may store their boats on club grounds. Make arrangements with LCYC office or at Registration Desk.

Launching: Multihulls may launch from Jacobs Creek Park. Details will be available at registration. All other boats may launch from LCYC.

Traffic Control: To relieve congestion, parking is not permitted on the shoulders of the road from trailer storage areas to clubhouse. Designated rigging/parking areas map will be given on arrival.

LCYC Accommodations: Camping is permitted on the club grounds. Showers and toilets are available at the clubhouse. Open campfire are NOT permitted
